Arohan is set up to mitigate the unemployment problems in rural India. The trainings and skill upgradation programmes are geared towards entrepreneurship development through demonstration and capacity building for income enhancement. The centre provides training sessions free of cost.

Advit's Rural Self Employment Training Centre

- Spread on a 3,000 sq yard area
- Energy efficient building – direction, design, construction material (is a naturally air-cooled building)
- Aimed to be a net zero building - no steel/ iron in the building structure, use of
 - Fly ash bricks for construction
 - Revival of local architecture and indigenous trees
 - Water sufficient – recharges all rainwater for annual use
 - Is equipped with solar street-lights, solar mobile charging unit, solar water pump, a kitchen running on biogas
 - Houses various community led activities - tailoring, paper mache, crochet, food drying, spice grinding and packaging
